Do not place any objects on the top of this unit. Do not place other appliance(including amplifiers)that produce heat on the top of this unit. Be sure to remove the disc when moving this unit. This unit is designed for continuous use. The power plug should be unplugged from the outlet when left unused for a long period of time.

#### 2. Caution

# 7. DVD Player Operations

\* After connection to the system is completed by connection method in Chapter 6, you can check the operations by following steps.


#### STEP 1:

Press the POWER button, starting logo is displayed in the screen. Then, depending on the disc status (DISC LOADING/NO DISC), the following screen is displayed.

#### STEP 2:

Press the Open/Close button in remote control or Eject button of the Unit, Tray is opened or closed automatically.



#### STEP 3:

Load a disc in disc tray and press the Open/Close button, or Eject Button of the Unit, The player identifies disc type automatically and disc type is displayed in the left top of TV screen. And, disc type is also displayed in operating status display of this player. It will automatically start to play.

#### STEP 4:

If the power button of the Unit or standby button of Remote Controller is pressed, the Unit power is under standby Mode, Again the power button or stand by button is pressed, power turns on and the Unit starts to play automatically.

\*When the Unit goes under standby Mode, LED lights on and in this case, If the External input is connected, It will automatically displays external input picture.

#### 8-1. Screen Display



# 8-2. P/N (Setting of TV receiving method)

Press the P/N button to select a proper TV signal. (NTSC, PAL and MULTI mode is sequentially shown on left top of screen)



#### 8-3. PBC FUNCTION

PBC ON: If 'Playback Control" is written in VCD2.0 disc or the case, you can select specific scene or information using main menu displayed on the TV/monitor.

- ① Press number buttons(0~9) to select a desired main menu displayed.

  If you select a desired main menu, submenu is displyed on TV/monitor.
- 2 Select specific submenu to be played.
- ③ Press STOP button to stop play. It moves on the prior submenu.
- 4 Press STOP button again to move on main menu.

#### 8-4. RANDOM FUNCTION

① AUDIO CD.

Press STOP button and then RANDOM button while you're listening audio CD. SHUFFLE ON is displayed on TV/monitor. Audio is played in random order, but it does not play repeatedly.

② MP3 CD.

Press STOP button and then RANDOM button. RANDOM ON is displayed on TV/monitor. Audio is played In random order, and it does play repeatedly.

③ VCD 2.0.

Use VCD 2,0 with "Playback Control". Press PBC button to turn PBC OFF and RANDOM button

#### 8-5. Track (Selecting audio language)

Press the TRACK button in remote control several times to select various audio languages. This player supports up to 8 audio languages. (This function can work only in the DVD disc supporting this function)



#### 8-6. Angle (Selecting watch angle)

When you watch a DVD disc such as sports or game, press the ANGLE button in remote control several times to watch the same scene from different angles. (This function can work only in the DVD disc supporting this function)



#### 8-7. Subtitle (Selecting subtitle language)

Press the SUBTITLE button in remote control several times to select various subtitle languages. (This function can work only in the DVD disc supporting this function)





#### 8-8. PROGRAM

- ① Press STOP button. In case of VCD, press PBC button to turn PBC OFF.
- ② Press PROGRAM button. "PROGRAM P 00:00" is displayed on the left-up side of TV/monitor.
- ③ Press number buttons(0-9) to select desired chapters or tracks.
  PROGRAM P 00:00 (First 00 : selected tracks, Last 00 : track number)
- 4 Press ENTER button. The selected tracks are played in order.
- ⑤ Press STOP button to stop PROGRAM function.

# 8-9. ▶, ◀, ▲, ▼(Moving to various directions)

You can move the desired direction variously. These buttons allow you to set up other items conveniently.



#### 8-10. Number button

You can use number button to input numbers. To input number 10 or more, press the +10 button and press the next number button.



#### 8-11. GOTO(Selecting the location to play)

- ① Press the GOTO button and select the desired title and chapter or time, playing is started from the selected part, At this time, press the PLAY button to start,
- 2 Press the GOTO button first and input the desired Title and Chapter.
- ③ You can input the desired starting time by pressing the GOTO Button once more

#### 8-12. A-B(Playing between two specific points)

- ① Press the A-B button once, starting point is specified.
- ② Press the A-B button twice, ending point is specified. Then, disc is played between specified A and B point repeatedly.
- ③ Press the A-B button three times, A-B Repeat Play function is finished.







#### 8-13. Repeat(Repeat setup)

Title or chapter can be repeated. In addition, the whole playing track or title can be displayed repeatedly.



#### 8-14. Zoom(Screen zoom-in or zoom-out)

Every time you press the ZOOM button, screen can be zoomed in one and a half times, double, and quadruple.



#### 8-15. Volume(Adjusting volume/key)

Press the  $\triangle$  or Up button of VOLUME buttons, sound goes higher. In contrast, press the  $\nabla$  or Down button, sound goes lower.



#### 8-16. Mute(No sound)

Press the MUTE button in remote control once, No sound is released. Again, press it, sound can be heard.



#### 8-17. Play/Stop

During playback, press the STOP button in this player or STOP button in remote control once, stopped point is remembered. At this time, press the PLAY button, playback is started from the stopped point.

If once again, press STOP Button of the Remote Controller or the Unit, It will completely stop to play.



#### \* VCD PLAY

If you want to replay from the stopped scene of VCD, please press PBC button firstly to make PBC OFF as the unit is originally set on PBC ON, and then press STOP button and RESUME button in order. If you do not press PBC button firstly to keep PBC ON, and then do press STOP button, it automatically go to the first scene.

#### 8-18. Pause

If you stop the current playback for a moment, press the PAUSE button. Press the PAUSE button again, playback is re-started.



# 8-19. FWD/BWD(Forward/Backward search)

Press the FORWARD/BACKWARD button in remote control repeatedly, screen is played forward or backward at double, quadruple, octuple, and twentyfold speed. If you play a disc at the normal speed, press the PLAY button again. (Subject to disc type, disc can be played at double, treble, quadruple, sextuple, and octuple speed).

# 8-20. Step(Still picture)

Every time you press the STEP button in remote control, each scene can be displayed. If you like to play the disc in the current status, press the PLAY button.

# 8-21. Slow

Each time you press SLOW button of remote controller, It plays 1/2, 1/4, 1/8 times in forward Direction and 1/2, 1/4, 1/8 times in backward Direction. If you want to play normal mode, press play button



# 9. Setup


Load a DVD disc in disc tray and press the SETUP button, initial settings screen is displayed. (Sometimes, if you press the SETUP button, you are required to input password. At this time, input 0000 that is specified initially) To exit the initial settings screen, press the SETUP button again.

In the GENERAL SETUP menu, you can select audio and video output.




#### 1 TV DISPLAY







If your Amp or other audio system can receive digital audio input, you just connect the cable to Digital audio out jack in the rear part of this player and then select SPDIF/RAW or SPDIF/PCM type. If digital audio out signal is supplied to audio system or receiver unavailable of digital decoding, it causes high-tone noise and can damage your speakers.

DTS DVD disc sound is displayed only if DVD player is connected to Amp equipped with DTS decoder.



#### 7 CAPTION

You can select CAPTION or non-CAPTION mode in screen by setting this menu.

You can select screen saver function in this menu.



#### 9-2. AUDIO SETUP

In the GENERAL SETUP, select the ANALOG in the audio out menu. Then, DOWN MIX setting menu is displayed.

#### 1 AUDIO MODE

If your TV/Monitor set can receive only one audio in and you want to listen with TV/Monitor, you just connect TV/Monitor to L or R jack in the rear part of this player and select the LT/RT in the menu. If you use TV/Monitor or Amp available of stereo input, you must select STEREO in the



1. First, please take the PWMS M3 X 4 <4EA> screws off located on the side parts of cover.




2. Place and install mounting Brackets where PWMS M3 X 4 screws have been tightened.
